

Public Transit (TTC) Directions

TTC Option 1a: Subway—getting off at Queen's Park Station (on the University line) and walk outside.

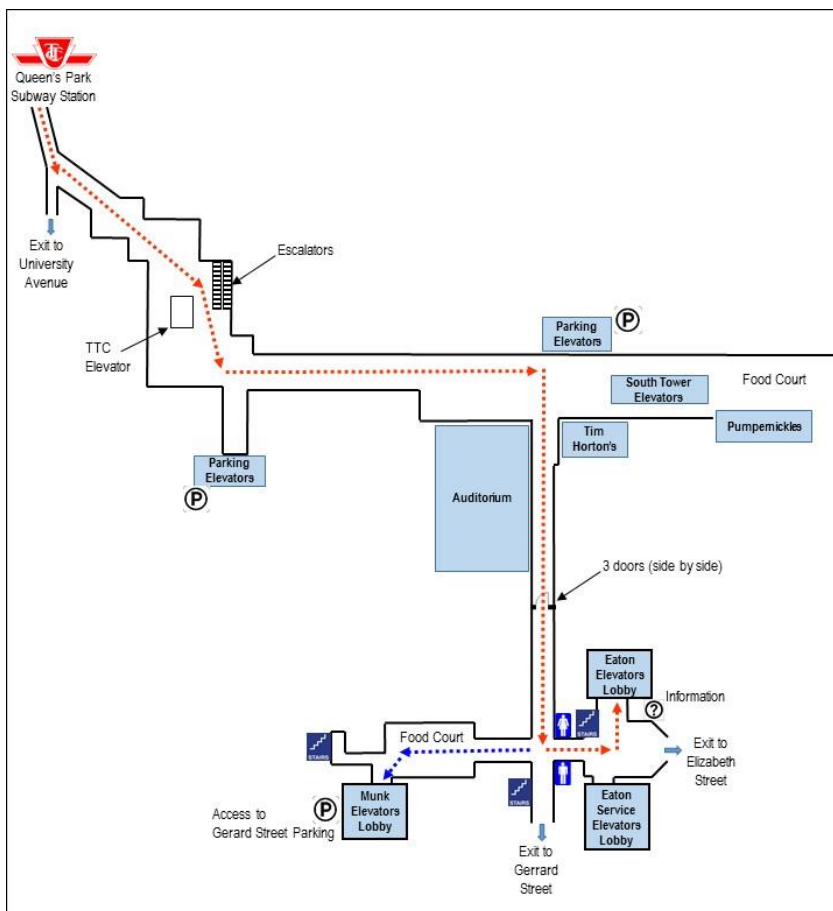
- Exit on University Avenue south-east side and walk to University Avenue
- Walk south on the left side of the road for about three minutes or one block
- The University Avenue entrance of Toronto General Hospital is on your left

TTC Option 1b: Subway—getting off at Queen's Park Station (on the University line) and walk inside through the MaRS building.

TTC Option 2: Subway—getting off at College Station (on the Yonge line)

- Take the Carlton / College Street streetcar (#506) Westbound
- After about 4 minutes, get off at Elizabeth Street
- Walk south on the right side of the street for about 3 minutes
- The Elizabeth Street entrance of Toronto General Hospital is on your right

TTC Option 3: Carlton / College Street Streetcar (#506)

For the Elizabeth Street entrance of Toronto General Hospital:

- Exit the Carlton / College Streetcar at Elizabeth Street
- Walk south one block on the right (West) side of the street for about 3 minutes
- The Elizabeth Street entrance of Toronto General Hospital is on your right

For the University Avenue entrance of Toronto General Hospital:

- Exit the Carlton / College Streetcar at University Avenue
- Walk south on the left side of the road for about 3 minutes or one block
- The University Avenue entrance of Toronto General Hospital is on your left

TTC Option 4: Wheel-Trans

Wheel-Trans is a specialized accessible transit service for people with physical disabilities. Wheel-Trans makes door-to-door arrangements.

Driving Option 1: From the 401

- Drive south on Avenue Road, around Queen's Park
- Avenue Road becomes University Avenue south of the Provincial Legislature
- Toronto General Hospital is located just south of College Street

Driving Option 2: From the Gardiner Expressway

- Exit on York Street and travel northbound
 - York Street turns into University Avenue
 - Toronto General Hospital is located just north of Gerrard Street

Inside TGH Option 1 (Coming into Toronto General Hospital through the Elizabeth Street entrance or the Gerrard Street entrance - Level G)

- Take one of the Eaton Elevators to the 8th floor
- Walk towards the side with arm chairs (follow the red dotted arrows in the map below)
- When you reach the arm chairs, turn right
- The Dalglish Family Hearts and Mind Clinic for 22q11.2 Deletion Syndrome is on your right.

Inside TGH Option 2 (Coming into Toronto General Hospital through the University Avenue entrance - Level L)

- Take one of the Munk Elevators to the 8th floor
- Once you exit the elevator lobby, turn right (follow the blue dotted arrows in the map below)
- Walk along the corridor
- Walk past the set of washrooms on your left
- The Dalglish Family Hearts and Mind Clinic for Adults with 22q11.2 Deletion Syndrome is on your left.
