Dr. Nikolai Gil D. Reyes is a MSc student of the Institute of Medical Science and is concomitantly doing a clinical fellowship at the Edmond J. Safra Program in Parkinson's Disease and the Morton and Gloria Shulman Movement Disorders Clinic at Toronto Western Hospital. He is a recipient of the 2023-2025 Parkinson Canada Clinical Research Fellowship Award and the 2024 Brain and Behavior Research Foundation (BBRF) Young Investigator Grant.

Working with both the Dalglish Family 22q Clinic and the TWH Movement Disorders team, Dr. Reyes is involved in providing clinical care for patients with 22q11.2 deletion syndrome (22q11.2DS) who have movement disorders. His research interests include diagnosis and treatment strategies for Parkinson's Disease (PD) and other parkinsonian syndromes, genetic movement disorders, and ataxias. His current work aims to investigate potential genetic factors that affect the risk of parkinsonism related and unrelated to antipsychotic treatment using 22q11.2 microdeletion as a high-risk model.
