Dr. Nikolai Gil Reyes is a MSc student of the Institute of Medical science and is concomitantly doing a clinical fellowship at the Edmond J. Safra Program in Parkinson's Disease and the Morton and Gloria Shulman Movement Disorders Clinic at Toronto Western Hospital. He is a recipient of the 2023-2025 Parkinson Canada Clinical Research Fellowship Award. His research interests include diagnosis and treatment strategies for Parkinson's Disease (PD) and other parkinsonian syndromes, genetic movement disorders, and ataxias.

Working with both the Dalglish Family 22q Clinic and the TWH Movement Disorders team, Nikolai is involved in providing clinical care for patients with 22q11.2 deletion syndrome (22q11.2DS) who have movement disorders. He is also pursuing genotype-phenotype correlation research for 22q11.2DS-associated PD.
