

# Shengjie Ying, MSc

## MD/PhD Candidate

Shengjie completed his master's degree at the University of Toronto from 2020–2022, under the supervision of Dr. Anne Bassett. His research was on the influence of genome-wide variation on schizophrenia and hypertriglyceridemia in 22q11.2 deletion syndrome. These findings help advance our understanding of the highly variable expression of complex disorders associated with 22q and provide methods of risk stratification that may become clinically useful.

Shengjie is currently an MD/PhD candidate at the Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry at Western University, and continues to collaborate on research projects with Dr. Bassett's lab.

Shengjie was the 2021 recipient of the CIHR Canada Graduate Scholars Master's (CGS-M) Award and of the Joseph Wong Memorial Graduate Award from the Institute of Medical Sciences, University of Toronto.
